
Further to our recent communication on the 'Upcoming ICB advice on the evolution of the PRB from 2017' sent on the 13<sup>th</sup> May 2016, I am pleased to enclose a draft of the paper on the evolution of the PRB produced by CANSO, IACA and IATA on a bilateral basis.

Please note that this work is not an agreed ICB position, but is now being brought into the fold of the Institutional Sub-Group for agreement of an ICB position through written approval ahead of SSC/61, but I am confident that no big changes to the draft paper will be necessary.

We are distributing this paper to the Commission as an 'unofficial' handout to give you a feeling of where the ICB is heading. We feel this is important ahead of the upcoming ad-hoc SSC on 2 June, and also SSC/61 on 21-22<sup>nd</sup> June, where setting up the group of experts designated as the PRB of the Single European Sky from 2017 will be discussed and voted upon. We aim to send through the final industry approved position to the Commission ahead of SSC/61.

We remain at your service on this important issue, and hope that the advice being developed by the ICB is of value to the Commission despite the difficult timeframe.
